Definitions

Six-Clicks: the ease of finding personal information (names, ages, addresses, school, schedule, etc.) to exploit, harm or even employ

Sexting: sending sexual based pictures and messages using cell phone, tablet or computer technology

Sextortion: a form of sexual extortion, the extortion of a person through the use of the history of their sexual conduct (such as saved sexting messages)

COPPA: Children's Online Privacy and Protection Act



Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)

Rule Summary: COPPA imposes certain requirements on operators of websites or online services directed to children under 13 years of age, and on operators of other websites or online services that have actual knowledge that they are collecting personal information online from a child under 13 years of age.



- You must be 13 for SM


























- COPPA: Requires users to be age 13

Privacy: Default is zero Privacy


Negative: Misleading that pictures actually disappear. Nudes are often sent by minors. Streaks, Bullying, Snap Map, SnapCash.






Snap Map

- Uses Geolocation to reveal user's locations, latitude and longitude
- Privacy Danger
- Must turn on Ghost Mode






Music Apps

Privacy: "Anonymous" yet known


Negative: Mean, gossipy,




Self-Made Child Pornography Federal Offense for Parents
