Gradual Release of Responsibility (GRR) model of instruction designed to create independent learners.

- STREAM curriculum model integrating Religion and Arts into STEM content areas merging 21st century teaching and inquiry-based learning

- Arts, Foreign Language, and Specialty classes for a well rounded learning environment for our students including music, art, physical education, and Spanish
- English Language Learner (ELL) student supports and certified staff support
- 1:1 Technology with Chromebooks for grades 4-8
- Digital Citizenship and Common Sense Media curriculum school with K-8 instruction
- Guided Reading instruction with Guided Reading Leveled Bookroom and Daily 5 based pedagogy to ensure student growth for all learners

Behavior

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS) & Restorative Justice Discipline Model

- School-wide implementation of positive behavior interventions and support that is an application of a behaviorally-based systems approach to effective learning environments and student behavioral expectations.
- Three-pronged restorative school discipline approach that focuses on creating positive school learning climates through prevention with clear, consistent, and fair expectations and consequences to address student misbehaviors.
- Responsive administrative team (Principal, two Assistant Principals, and Dean of School) to help support teachers, students, and families
- Two school counselors on staff
- Social Groups and Restorative Circles
- Proactive approach to social media education and safety strategies with student social media contracts
- Collaborative partnerships with community organizations to ensure our students are responsible, safe, and respectful citizens.
