Here is what you need to know:

What is Race for Education?

It's an annual fundraiser to raise money for our school where students are actively involved without selling items door to door.

When is Race for Education this year?

Race for Education will be held during school on **Friday, April 26, 2019.**

How does Race for Education work?

1. School families provide names and addresses of potential sponsors.
2. Students write a note at school asking sponsors to contribute a gift.
3. Students walk/run for 50 minutes on school grounds on Race day.
4. Parents contact school for a list of donors for their children.
5. Students send thank you notes from home.

How are Race for Education funds used?

Funds raised go toward the educational needs of our school such as Accelerated Reading Programs, textbooks, Star Math testing materials and technology based instruction enhancements like BrainPop.

How much money is raised?

In 2018, we raised **\$52,000** after expenses! Let's beat that amount this year!

How can Parents Help?

1. Race for Education Kick-off Packets will go home March 11 and will include mailing labels for you to complete. Our goal is **5,200** labels, or 7 labels/student.
2. Volunteer to help the day of Race or with opening/alphabetizing mailers.
3. Help your student thank their donors.
