

## ST. PIUS X / ST. LEO SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Supply List for 2019-2020 School Year

Please bring supplies to Open House (Aug. 13<sup>th</sup>) or on the first day of school (Aug. 15<sup>th</sup>).

These supplies are to be in each student's possession throughout the entire school year, which means that some of them may have to be purchased more than once during the school year. All supplies must be purchased. **Please label supplies with your child's name and room number.** We request that students do not bring white-out to school.

### KINDERGARTEN

25 (or more) glue sticks  
4 boxes Crayons (box of 24 – **no bigger than 24**)  
1 box of sharpened pencils (#2)  
1 box of 10 classic colored markers  
2 8-color watercolor tray  
Pointed scissors (kid's size)

1 package of 4 skinny highlighters

2 **3-pronged folders** – 1 blue, 1 red

1 plastic 8x5 school box (**no bigger, no metal, no locks**)  
2 1" binders (basic colors, **with pocket on inside**)  
1 box Kleenex  
1 plain old white t-shirt for gym class (a size bigger than the student's current size)  
1 ream of plain white copy paper  
1-2 clorox wipes  
1 box regular size band-aids  
1 box knee/elbow size band-aids or variety - optional

2 black fine point Sharpie marker (not ultra fine)  
1 container of clorox wipes  
1 ream of plain white copy paper

1 8-color watercolor tray paints  
1 box regular-sized band-aids  
Hand sanitizer (8-12 oz)

### GRADE 4

Plastic cover expandable files with **at least 13 files**  
- **no thicker than 2 inches**  
3 spiral wide-lined notebooks  
Elmer's glue bottle and glue sticks  
2 large boxes of Kleenex  
1 assignment notebook (prefer SPSL assignment notebook - available in school office)  
1 package notebook paper with **wide lines – no college ruled**  
2 packages lined index cards – 3 x 5 size  
1 highlighter  
3 2-pocket folders  
1 ream of plain white copy paper  
2 clorox wipes containers - optional  
Hand sanitizer - optional  
1 box regular-sized band-aids – optional  
1 set dry erase markers - optional

## **GRADE 5**

8 **SEPARATE SPIRAL** notebooks (8½ x 11 – wide ruled)  
3 packages of loose leaf, wide-ruled paper  
Expandable (at least 7 pockets)  
Ruler with metric & inches

Ball point pens - red & blue or black  
Highlighters – need two different colors  
1 package thin and/or thick markers  
Calculator  
1 pkg (100) 3 x 5 index cards  
Post It Notes Flags/File Tabs  
3-4 glue sticks  
2 bottles white glue  
3 rolls of scotch tape  
2 large boxes of Kleenex  
1 box dry erase markers (Expo)  
1 ream of plain white copy paper  
1 container of clorox wipes  
**NO** white-out, permanent markers, sharpies, or staplers

## **P.E. – ALL GRADES**

\*Boys – uniform shorts or pants are required for PE classes; Girls (Grades K-4) – uniform shorts or skorts are required for PE classes, jumpers must be removed prior to coming to PE and basketball or soccer length shorts must be worn, with no words printed on the back side; Girls (Grades 5-8) – uniform shorts, uniform pants or uniform skirts are required for PE classes.

\* Tennis shoes that fit securely on feet are required for PE classes - shoes should either tie or have velcro. Shoes with good foot support are strongly recommended. NOT ALLOWED: ‘Sperrys’, moccasins, hiking shoes, boots, shoes with metal or slip-on shoes.

\* Hair – Girls with long hair are encouraged to bring hair ties to pull their hair back.

\* Jewelry - Necklaces, bracelets and watches may not be worn in PE class and should remain in the student’s desk. Uniform-appropriate post earrings (for girls) are the only jewelry allowed during PE class.
