# QTEGO BIDDING AND LIVE EVENT PARTICIPATION 

## How will Qtego work?

ANY electronic device with an internet connection or cell phone with texting capabilities can be used to bid on auction items, sign up for parties, or donate dollars to a specific cause. Your phone does not need to be a "smart" phone. Cell phone bids, purchases, and donations work through text messaging OR simply register and log in on our bidding platform spsl.home.qtego.net - to bid, donate, and sign-up for parties. There is no registration fee to buy or bid on items from October 16 to October 22 so register today!

To participate in the live event, please return your RSVP card by October 16. You will need to register and log in on our bidding platform - spsl.home.qtego.net - where you can bid, donate, and watch the live-streamed event on October 24. Helpful hint - You can see photos of all the items available for bid or purchase on spsl.home.qtego.net.

## How do I enable my cell phone to participate in the bidding?

Pre-registration can be completed at spsl.home.qtego.net. You can pre-register cell phones you plan to use during the fundraiser, along with a credit card.

## What happens once I'm registered?

If you are bidding via cell phone, Qtego will send a text response. You respond to this text message for placing bids - smartphone users can click on the personal bidding link you will receive via text upon registration. At the end of the event, you will "check out" and your total amount will be charged to your pre-registered credit card. You will receive a texted receipt link.

## What if I'm outbid on an item?

You will be notified via text message if you are outbid. To increase your bid amount, reply to the text with your new bid amount.

## What if my cell phone doesn't have texting capabilities?

No worries! You don't need a cell phone. Any electronic device with an internet connection can be used for bidding. Simply log in at spsl.home.qtego.net to bid, donate, and more!

## Remember:

Pre-register for the event online at spsl.home. qtego.net and add a cell phone that you will use for bidding during the event to have the most flexibility and ease of participation.
I) Bid on an auction item against others vying for the same item.
2) Insta-Buy to purchase an item at a set (pre-determined) price.
3) GIVE is a special portion of the event aimed at raising $\$ 12,000$ for the operational needs of the school. You can make monetary GIVE donations anytime after October 16 and during the live event.

## THREE WAYS TO USE QTEGO

## I. Bid on an Item

-Reply to any Qtego text message with the 3-digit item number and a whole dollar amount you wish to bid.
(Example:To bid $\$ 75$ on item number I23, reply to any Qtego text with 123 75 and SEND.)
-Receive a text from Qtego confirming your bid and if someone outbids you.

## Check the Current Bid on an Item

Reply to any Qtego text message with the 3-digit item number.
(Example:To check current bid on item number I23, reply to any Qtego text with 123 and SEND.)

## Set up Automated Bidding (set a maximum bid amount on an item)

-Reply to any Qtego text message with the 3-digit item number, space, bid amount, space, $M$ (to indicate maximum you are willing to bid).
(Example:To set a maximum bid of $\$ 75$ on item number I23, reply to any Qtego text with 12375 M.) The system will automatically bid for you until you win or your maximum is met!

## Track Bidding Status (for all of your items)

-Reply to any Qtego text with the word STATUS and then SEND.
-Receive a text from Qtego listing all items of which you are the current high bidder.

## 2. Purchase via an Insta-Buy Item

(Buying an item which has a pre-determined or set price, ie: Sign Up Parties and Wine Pull.)
-Reply to any Qtego text with BUY followed by the 3-digit item number.
(Example:To buy item 246, reply BUY 246.)

To buy more than one item with a set price, reply BUY, the 3-digit item number and the quantity of that item number.
(Example:To buy 4 of the item number 246, reply with BUY 246 4 and SEND.)

## 3. GIVE

-Reply to any Qtego text with the word GIVE followed by the amount.
(Example:To Give $\$ 100$, simply reply to any Qtego text with GIVE IOO and SEND).
