What is a Sign-up Party?

A Sign-Up party is a party or event that parents, a group of parents or teachers agree to host for as many people as they feel appropriate for the specific activity/party. Attendees can be adults, children or a combination of the two. Tickets to the events are purchased at the 2021 SPSL Fundraiser in a variety of price ranges. The hosts cover all party expenses and 100% of the funds raised by the event benefit our school programs.

What kinds of parties work well?

Just to give you some ideas from past parties...


- For Kids → Putt-Putt golf, a day at Hummel Park, Sledding party, Bowling, Volleyball tournament, pool party, outdoor games and fun.
- For Adults or Couples → Whiskey Tasting, Movie Night, Tennis lessons, Outdoor/Lawn games, Pints & Painting, Mom's Day Out.
- For Families → Outdoor Movie Night, Bonfire and Smores, pool party.

Parties don't need to be elaborate, but they can be! They can be as simple as movie night, hike, organized team game at a park or events such as a progressive dinner hosted by multiple families.

- 2) Things we need to know for your party:
 - What type of party?
 - Who is/are the host(s)?
 - How many guests can you accommodate?
 - When is the party? (listing at least the month is helpful, though not necessary)
 - Where is the party? (if unknown, that's okay, just say TBD)
 - Who is the party for? (adults, kids, families, etc.)
- 3) Guests will sign up for your party and pay a fee at the **2021 SPSL Fundraiser**; the fee goes to the school.
- 4) Then you have the party! Following the Fundraiser, we will email you a list of the people who purchased/signed-up for your party. Just set a date and let your guest know all the details.
