P.E. – ALL GRADES

*Boys – uniform shorts or pants are required for PE classes; Girls (Grades K-4) – uniform shorts or skorts are required for PE classes, jumpers must be removed prior to coming to PE and basketball or soccer length shorts must be worn, with no words printed on the back side; Girls (Grades 5-8) – uniform shorts, uniform pants or uniform skirts are required for PE classes.

* Tennis shoes that <u>fit securely</u> on feet are required for PE classes - shoes should either tie or have velcro. Shoes with <u>good foot support</u> are strongly recommended. NOT ALLOWED: 'Sperrys', moccasins, hiking shoes, boots, shoes with metal, or slip-on shoes.
