FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The Value of a SPSL Education

Enrollment is up at St. Pius X / St. Leo School for the 2024-25 school year. There were 609 students in Kindergarten-8th grade at the close of the last school year. This year, there are 623 students enrolled in those grades.

Junior high and Kindergarten have experienced the greatest enrollment increases. For instance, last year SPSL had 60 Kindergarten students, while this year, we welcomed 70 Kindergartners (with an extensive wait list). There is significant demand for all day Pre-Kindergarten offerings at SPSL as well. All of our 4 year old Pre-K programs are currently full with a waitlist. SPSL is excited to welcome these young learners and their families to the SPSL School community!

For the 2024-25 school year, the cost to educate a student at SPSL is \$7,572 per student. The generous support of alumni, donors, parents, parishioners, and friends covers the difference between the actual cost to educate and the tuition price that is charged per student.


Fundraising and parish support from St. Pius X and St. Leo the Great provide the revenue for approximately 60% of the school operating budget. This makes it possible to charge an affordable tuition price of \$3,925 per student.

Approximately 60% of SPSL families pay the entire tuition price for their student(s). Every SPSL family pays tuition, and those who qualify are strongly encouraged to utilize tuition assistance sources such as Children's Scholarship Fund.

For the 2024-25 school year, SPSL has awarded approximately \$550,000 in tuition assistance from SPSL Tuition Assistance and the Education Partners Program. SPSL is grateful for the generous gifts that make a SPSL education available to families for whom it would otherwise be out of reach.




